



The Greatest Showman (GS) Mobile Camp Program



What a GS Mobile Camp Looks Like

- This camp looks more like a day camp and will resemble what our Fine Tuner Day Camp looks like. It will have many of the same qualities, energy and information as our summertime Leadership and Cattle Showmanship Camp just not as long, and will be condensed.
- GS Mobile Camps will run from 9am- 4pm of camp time (unless otherwise agreed upon).
- Check in will start at 8am with camp starting promptly at 9am.
- A 30 (+/-) min lunch time will be built in around noon.
- Additional breaks will also be built in.
- Camp will end at 4pm to offer time for questions and private lesson time after camp.
- A full camp schedule and agenda will be sent to you following signing up for the GS Mobile Camp Program.
- Camps are designed to be high energy, interactive, hands on, educational and above all designed to have a great time to learn.

What You Do

- Supply a Facility.
- Get the **Minimum 10 Camper Requirement** to sign up using our Sign Up/ Payment Link we will send you.
 - If you do not think you will get the 10 minimum required campers please call us to discuss options.
- Set up a lunch for Campers/ Families (We will provide you a total number of meals 1 week in advance).
- Be sure each student brings a steer or heifer, show supplies, and everything they would bring to a show.
- Tell us the content you would like covered.
 - Content Area Options Include:
 - Option 1- Focus 75% of camp on showmanship skills in the ring and 25% of camp on leadership skills.
 - Option 2- Focus 50% of camp on showmanship skills in the ring and 50% of camp on leadership skills.
 - Option 3- Focus 50% of camp on showmanship skills in the ring and 50% of camp on fitting/ clipping.
 - Option 4- Focus 50% of camp on showmanship skills in the ring, 25% of camp on leadership skills and 25% of camp on fitting/ clipping.

Facility Requirements

- County Facilities, Covered Rodeo Arenas, Ag Barn Facilities that have a covered show ring all work great.
- Facilities Must Have the Following:
 - Covered Ring Area (needs to be a large ring to fit 8+ calves in ring at a time).
 - Covered Stalling Area for cattle.
 - Electricity.
 - Meeting Room or Open Room for Campers/ Families to Eat and Meet.

What We Do

- Take care of Camper Sign Up & Payments.
- Prepare all content & materials for camp including leadership icebreakers and workshops.
- Provide Special Guests, if available.
- Supply our own pa system, projector, screen and computer.
- Supply each camper with a name tag lanyard and t-shirt.
- Supply awards to include banners, giveaways & scholarship(s). (Scholarships funded by ZBLT Foundation)
- We will also bring some show supplies to share and a minimum 2 animals of our own.

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What Do Payments and Donations Look Like

- Cost of Camp is **\$150 per camper** and includes everything listed under “What We Do”.
 - All payments must be paid to ZBLT Show Calves/ ZBLT Foundation and sign up must be done through the Personalized Sign Up/ Payment Link that we send you after chapter/ club sign up.
- Donation Options:
 - 10-19 Campers we will donate 30% of the proceeds back to the FFA Chapter or 4-H Club
 - 20-29 Campers we will donate 40% of the proceeds back to the FFA Chapter or 4-H Club
 - 30+ Campers we will donate 50% of the proceeds back to the FFA Chapter or 4-H Club
 - Additional Incentives:
 - Any private lessons scheduled and paid for a minimum 1 week prior to the scheduled camp, we will donate 50% of proceeds of these scheduled private lessons back to the FFA Chapter or 4-H Club.
 - Any private lessons scheduled within 1 week of camp or on the day of camp, we will donate 25% of proceeds of these private lessons back to the FFA Chapter or 4-H Club.
- **Example:**
 - Your FFA Chapter hosts a camp and supplies lunch for 22 campers and families. Additionally you have 4 campers each sign up for a 1 hour private lesson.
 - 22 campers at \$150 each= \$3,300.00
 - 4 camper, 1 hour private lesson at \$75 each= \$300.00 (scheduled 1 week prior to camp)
 - Total Camp Proceeds= \$3,600.00
 - ZBLT Show Calves, LLC. / ZBLT Foundation would donate 40% of proceeds from total campers at camp and 50% of private lessons scheduled.
 - Total Donation Amount to be given on the same day as camp= \$1,470.00

Additional Notes

- Your camp can be open to the public. You do not have to limit it to just your chapter or club.
- Camps must be scheduled a minimum 30 days prior to your projected or planned date.
 - This is so we can have shirts/ banners/ prizes/ etc. ordered and ready.
- If you feel you will not meet the 10 minimum campers please call for additional options.
- If you feel you will exceed 30 campers please call so we can discuss facilities and the camp schedule.
